



REGULATIONS

ON THE ORGANIZATION AND CONDUCT OF GRADUATION, LICENSE / DIPLOMA, SELECTION AND DISSERTATION EXAMS

preamble

This Regulation was elaborated on the basis of: the National Education Law no.1 / 2011, of the Orders of the relevant ministry regarding the Framework Methodology for organizing and conducting the bachelor's / diploma and dissertation exams and the "Lucian Blaga" University Charter from Sibiu " .

The regulation lays down the general rules for the organization and conduct of graduation , bachelor's / diploma, selection and dissertation examinations.

"Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu is a higher education institution accredited in accordance with the law and consequently is an institution organizing exams to complete studies in higher education.

Every academic year, the final exam is organized in two sessions established by the Senate of the "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu with the approval of the structure of the academic year , and the date of the sessions is brought to the students' notice at least six months before the first day . registration of the first session.

General dispositions

Article 1

- (1) Completion of studies for graduates covered by the National Education Law no. 1/2011 ends for:
 - a) cycle I - university studies: with bachelor's degree or diploma exam for education in the field of engineering sciences ;
 - b) cycle II - master's degree studies : with dissertation exam .

Art .2¹

- (1) exam and the bachelor's / diploma exam consists of two tests:
 - a) test 1 - Assessment of basic and specialized knowledge;
 - b) test 2 - Presentation and presentation of the graduation, bachelor's / diploma thesis;
 - c)in the case of the Faculty of Medicine , within the test provided in let. a) there is also a practical test for each specialization ², except for the General ³Medicine specialization .
- (2) The dissertation exam consists of a single test: the presentation and presentation of the dissertation.
- (3) The presentation and presentation of the dissertation, bachelor's / diploma and dissertation is public.

- (4)⁴By way of derogation from the previous paragraphs, during the establishment of the state of alert, necessity or urgency , the graduation, bachelor 's / diploma , selection and dissertation exams may also be conducted online, in accordance with the provisions of the Procedure approved by the University Senate .
- (5)⁴ The online support is registered in full , for each candidate , and archived at the faculty level.
- (6)⁴ Participation of students in the exams provided in art. 143 of the National Education Law no. 1/2011, with the subsequent amendments and completions, which during the state of alert, necessity or state of emergency followed the activity of learning and teaching in the online mode is performed based on the Procedure approved by the University Senate.
- (7) At each test the examination is concluded by awarding a grade. The mark for each test must be at least **5.00**, except for the dissertation exam in which the passing mark is at least **6.00**.
- (8) Note 1 shall be calculated as a simple arithmetic mean to two decimal places, without rounding, of the marks awarded by the members of the committee. In test 2, the marks of the members of the examination board are whole numbers from 10 to 1, and the mark of test 2 is calculated as a simple arithmetic mean with two decimals, without rounding.
- (9) The average pass of the final exam, obtained as a simple arithmetic average of their test scores , when applicable, must be at least **6.00**.

Article 3

- (1) Ex -graduates or undergraduates / graduates of higher education graduates of accredited or authorized temporary programs / specializations and graduates who have passed the selection examination may take the exam .
- (2) "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu organizes graduation exams, bachelor's / diploma exams for its own graduates of accredited study programs, study programs authorized to operate temporarily for which the University has in the same field of license accredited study programs / specializations .
- (3) "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu can organize bachelor's / diploma exams for graduates of the programs of other state or privately authorized educational institutions, for which it is designated by the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sports. A framework collaboration protocol is being signed between ULBS and the host university for undergraduate students wishing to pursue a bachelor's degree.
- (4) The "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu, in the situation in which it is designated by the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sports, by order, organizes a selection exam. For private higher education graduates who fall within the provisions of Law no. 60/2000, as well as for the graduates of the specializations entered in liquidation / liquidated within the higher education institutions authorized to function provisionally, the selection exam consists of 5 written tests, except for the selection exam in the human medical-pharmaceutical field, which consists of 5 written tests and a specific practical test.
- (5) For graduates of specializations entered into liquidation / liquidated within accredited higher education institutions, the selection exam consists of 3 written tests, except for the selection exam in the human medical-pharmaceutical field, which consists of 3 written tests and a specific practical test.
- (6) The measures provided in par. (4) - (5) does not apply to graduates from

- specializations / study programs that went into liquidation by the decision of the university senate, as a result of the application of institutional development strategies , nor to graduates from specializations / study programs that went into liquidation due to non- submission within the legal term of the accreditation / periodic evaluation files
- (7) exam the passing grade is recognized in all subsequent graduation exams , but only in the institution where it was taken and promoted .
 - (8) If , at the national level, in a field of license there are only study programs / specializations authorized to operate provisionally, the graduates of these study programs / specializations will take the exam to complete the studies at accredited study programs / specializations " related ". These study / specialization programs are established by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education.
 - (9) In the case of study programs / specializations already liquidated, in which there are still graduates who have not taken or failed the final exams and for whom at national level, in the respective field of license, there are only authorized study programs / specializations to function provisionally , the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education establishes the accredited study programs / specializations at which they will take the final exams .

Candidate registration

Article 4

- (1) University "L ucian Blaga" from Sibiu organizes graduation exams for graduates own or other state or private higher education institutions , at :
 - a) programs / specializations for which he has accreditation under the law ;
 - b) study / specialization programs authorized to operate provisionally for which the institution has in the same field of license, accredited study / specialization programs;
- (2) "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu organizes dissertation exams only for its own graduates.
- (3) Candidates for the final examination must be registered at least 10 days before the beginning of the examination, either individually or by the higher education institution where they studied, based on the protocol concluded with this institution, based on a standard application. submitted to the secretariats of the faculties.
- (4) A copy of the dissertation, bachelor's / master's thesis, dissertation prepared by the candidate together with the report of the scientific coordinator is attached to the application. The paper will include assessments on the content of the paper and the grade awarded; the standard form (Annex 2) can be adapted as content, depending on the specifics, by the departments.
- (5) The marketing of scientific papers for the use by the buyer of the authorship of a dissertation, bachelor's / diploma, dissertation is prohibited. Each student will certify before the presentation for grading the originality of the bachelor's / diploma dissertation, as the case may be, by completing a specific document provided by the Department of Intellectual Property (Annex 5).
- (6) The coordinator / coordinators of the bachelor's / diploma dissertation paper are jointly and severally liable with the authors for ensuring the originality of its content. Teachers, scientific coordinators, will carefully evaluate all documents for the completion of the scientific work, including the certificate of intellectual property. In cases where there is evidence of plagiarism, the candidates (students) in question will be sanctioned with the exclusion from the exam to take the paper and with the obligation to repeat it in the following sessions.
- (7) If they do not pass or do not participate in test 2 of the bachelor's exam, the registration



for the 2nd test of the candidates, who in previous years have passed test 1, is done with the approval of the examination commission.

- (8) Candidates for the bachelor's / diploma exam must present the certificate of linguistic competence, in a language of international circulation, issued by the profile department of the University or by another specialized national or international institution recognized by the "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu⁵.
- (9) In order to obtain the certificate of linguistic competence in the "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu, the procedure will be as follows:
 - a) candidates from undergraduate specializations who have had a foreign language in the curriculum and have studied a compulsory, optional or optional subject in a foreign language for at least four semesters and have had promotion grades will receive the language proficiency certificate based on these grades;
 - b) candidates holding a certificate from recognized institutions and organizations who have completed at least 6 months of internships at foreign universities during their studies will receive a certificate of language proficiency;
 - c) Candidates who do not meet the conditions set out in points (a) or (b) will receive language proficiency certificates only if they pass the foreign language examination (test) organized by the profile department in May for the June -July session and during **January** for the February-March session.
- (10) Graduates of the study programs accredited in the "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu enroll and take the graduation exam, bachelor's / diploma, in accordance with the law, within this institution, and those of the programs authorized to operate provisionally, claim as appropriate, at ULBS (if there is an accredited field under the undergraduate program) or at another university (if there is no accredited field at ULBS under the undergraduate program).
- (11) Graduates of the study programs carried out by the "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu accredited or authorized to function provisionally may register and take, as the case may be, the graduation exam, license / diploma at another university organizing these exams only with the approval of the University Senate. "LUCIAN BLAGA" from Sibiu and the Senate of the university where he will take the final exam. The same condition is required for the graduation exam of the "LUCIAN BLAGA" University of Sibiu for graduates of accredited programs or authorized to work temporarily from other accredited universities.
- (12) Graduates who have registered but have not taken or failed the final examination in one of the two consecutive sessions (June-July, February-March) may register for a subsequent session in order to take it at the same institution or another institution (with the approval of the Rectorate of ULBS, based on the agreement of the faculty, as well as the Rectorate of the organizing institution), only for that specialization, provided that the candidate bears the related fees regarding the university fees, valid for the academic year in which the candidates register for the final exam.
- (13) graduates of "Lucian Blaga" University from Sibiu, who did not register for the final exam in other previously organized sessions, have the right to register for both the June -July and February - March sessions. They can take the exams free of charge in the two consecutive sessions (June - July, February-March). In case of not passing the final exams in one of the two consecutive sessions (June-July, respectively February-March), they can be taken in a subsequent session, with the candidate bearing the related expenses.

Article 5

(1) Registration files the bachelor's exam must contain:

- a) application type registration;
- b) baccalaureate diploma or equivalent in original or certified copy / certified copy "according to the original" by the persons assigned to this purpose;
- c) birth certificate in certified copy / certified copy "in accordance with the original" by the persons assigned to this designation;
- d) two ID photos;
- e) the certificate of linguistic competence (in accordance with art. 9, paragraph (3) of the Order of the Minister of Education, Research, Youth and Sports no. 3271 / 14.02.2012 and with the regulations of the "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu). This certificate of linguistic competence is valid for 2 academic years, and can also be used for master's and doctoral entrance exams at this university during this period);
- f) the license paper in printed format + electronic format (.doc ,. rtf , .pdf), accompanied by the report of the scientific coordinator, annex 5 and other specific documents / forms, prepared by the Departments and which will be present in the guidelines for the preparation of the papers of the license;
- g) proof of payment of the registration fee (if applicable);
- h) certificate issued by the graduated higher education institution, for candidates coming from other universities;
- i.i. the diploma supplement in original and copy according to the model given by the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sports, for graduates from other higher education institutions.

Article 6

(1) Dissertation examination application files must contain:

- a) application type registration;
- b) the baccalaureate diploma or its equivalent in the original;
- c) birth certificate in certified copy;
- d) two ID photos;
- e) printed dissertation paper + electronic format (.doc, .rtf , .pdf), accompanied by the report of the scientific coordinator and other specific documents / forms, prepared by the Departments and which will be present in the guidelines for compiling dissertation papers;
- f) proof payment of the registration fee (if applicable);

Examination boards

Article 7

- (1) The examination commissions for the completion of studies are established on study programs / specializations by the decision of the Rector at the proposal of the Departments of their Departments, validated by the Councils of the Faculties and with the approval of the University Senate. The commissions are made public on the website of each faculty.
- (2) Each committee shall normally consist of three members and shall consist of a chairperson, two members and a secretary, the latter having only administrative duties. On the proposals of the Councils of the Departments and with the approval of the University Senate, if necessary, the number of members of the commission may be 5 plus the secretary of the commission.
- (3) According to the law, the members of the final examination commission, the secretary of the final examination commission, the members of the written proofreading



commission and of the appeals resolution commissions may not be in a relationship with those evaluated or among themselves. spouses, relatives and kin up to and including the third degree.

- (4) The chair of the graduation examination commission must have the teaching degree of university professor or associate professor. The members of the commission must have the scientific title of doctor and the didactic degree at least of lecturer / head of works. The secretary of the commission must have at least the teaching degree of assistant professor and has only the attributions of document administration . The members of the commissions must be full - time teachers of ULBS .

Bachelor's / dissertation exam structure

Article 8

- (1) final exam for each academic year is organized in two sessions:
- a. the graduation, bachelor's / diploma exam between June 15 - July 15 and February 20 - March 20 (except for the Faculty of Medicine where the period is September) in the following order:
 - test 1: assessment *of basic and specialized knowledge* , exam (written, oral or practical test depending on the specifics of the fields) in the disciplines established by the Faculty Council. The Faculty Council also proposes the form of examination: written, oral or practical test and these proposals are approved by the Senate of the University, being annexes of this regulation ⁶. In the process of assessing the basic and specialized knowledge, the one - year exams taken during the bachelor's / diploma level studies will not be repeated .
 - test 2 : *graduation, bachelor's / diploma thesis* ;
 - b. exam between July 1-30 and if required between February 15 and March 15.
- (2) Each faculty will inform the candidates about the exam periods at the end of their studies, the conditions and the registration period, topics, bibliography, access to the library, preparation courses, by posting at the faculty headquarters and on the website at least 6 months before the first exam. license / dissertation.
- (3) date and time of entry for each test will be announced 24 hours before the test , by the secretary of the commission by posting on the notice board of the faculty / department and on the website .

Determining the topics and conducting the exam

Article 9

- (1) threads for test 1 *The assessment of basic and specialist knowledge* shall be determined on the basis of the following criteria:
- are in strict accordance with the content of the topic and bibliography displayed and communicated at least 6 months before the date of the exam,
 - ensures a balanced comprehension of the subject and can be solved by the candidates within the allotted time (maximum 3 hours for the written test),
 - make it possible to objectively assess candidates ' training , thinking ability and skills .
- (2) The subjects and the scales of correction for the written tests, as well as the scheduling of these tests are established by the license commission of the faculty / department. The variants of the subjects are elaborated an hour and a half before the tests. Exam

- subjects are determined by drawing lots from at least three variants of subjects.
- (3) The Chairman of the Licensing Commission shall appoint the composition of the Correction Board for the written examinations consisting of at least 2 members of the Licensing Commission. The departments will support the bachelor's / dissertation committee during the examination.
 - (4) Test 1 for the candidates of the Faculty of Medicine registered for the bachelor's exam consists of a national component which will be in the form of a written paper on the subject and bibliography announced by the organizing committee and, as the case may be, a specific component.
 - (5) The dissertation, bachelor's / diploma, dissertation is defended in the public meeting attended by the chairman of the committee, the secretary of the committee and at least one member of the committee. The Scientific Supervisor may take part in discussions on coordinated work.
 - (6) The grade for the dissertation, bachelor's / diploma, dissertation is awarded by the members of the examination board based on the assessment of the paper before the committee and the report prepared by the scientific supervisor. The final grade for this test results from the simple arithmetic mean of the marks given by each member of the committee present at the defense.
 - (7) The minutes with the marks awarded shall be signed by all members of the committee.
 - (8) The results obtained by the candidates for each test are communicated by posting at the headquarters of the faculties / departments and on the web page within a maximum of 48 hours from the date of the test .

Appeals

Article 10

- (1) Any appeals regarding the results of test 1 shall be submitted to the secretariat of the faculty / department within a maximum of 24 hours from the communication / display of the results and shall be resolved within a maximum of 48 hours from the end of the deadline for submission of appeals by a commission for analysis and resolution of appeals appointed by the Rector at the proposal of the chairman of the license commission, from among the specialized teachers who were not part of the commission that corrected the works.
- (2) If the difference between the initial grade and the grade given by the analysis committee and the settlement of appeals is greater than or equal to 0.5 points, the final grade for this test is that given by the analysis and settlement commission of appeals.
- (3) Appeals are resolved exclusively at the faculty level, and the decisions of the analysis commissions and the resolution of appeals are final.
- (4) The results obtained in the oral tests of artistic or sports aptitudes, in the defense of the graduation, bachelor's / diploma , dissertation works cannot be contested.

Bachelor's thesis / dissertation

Article 11

- (1) The purpose of the bachelor's thesis / dissertation is to assess the graduates' ability to conduct case studies, field research or to solve problems specific to the field of training, as the case may be.
- (2) Bachelor's / dissertation papers may have full-time scientific coordinators and tenured associate professors, as well as full-time and associate scientific researchers. The bachelor's / dissertation may have two or more scientific coordinators, in which case at least one of them will be the course holder, holding the title of doctor.



- (3) "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu encourages the participation of scientific coordinators from partner universities in the European Union. They can act as scientific coordinators for teachers at partner universities, with a cooperation agreement in force, if the agreement provides for cooperation in the field of research or student exchange.
- (4) A teacher can guide the works of graduates from another faculty, specialization, but the professional criteria and the requirements of the training of which the graduate is a part are valid. Graduates have the obligation to find out about the requirements and criteria of the department that manages the study program.
- (5) Candidates are advised to choose coordinators for their bachelor's / dissertation papers at least 1 year before enrolling in the final exam.
- (6) The formal and content requirements will be provided in the guidance for the elaboration of the license / dissertation works elaborated at the level of Departments. The requirements for the individual research / study on the bachelor's thesis / dissertation, the landmarks on the substantiation, documentation, design, elaboration, drafting, presentation of the paper, as well as the evaluation criteria will be brought to the notice of the graduates at least 1 year before the first day. registration of the first session through tutors and consultation hours conducted by teachers. Formal and content requirements will also be available on the notice board or on the Department's website.
- (7) Each coordinator of a bachelor's / dissertation paper submits in writing and officially registers, at the secretariat of the Department, a completed form 7, which characterizes the author's contribution and the degree of novelty of the paper, in the language of the respective line of study.
- (8) Bachelor's theses are prepared, developed, edited and supported in the language in which they were studied or in a widely used language (English, French, German), in the case of language and literature, respectively when this was the language predominant study of specialization.
- (9) Candidates who resort to fraud by copying the entire paper, dissertation or part thereof, failing to comply with the referral rules, once the fraud is proven, will be removed from the examination, and if they have paid the examination fee completion of studies, it is not refundable.

Particular evidence

Art.12.

- (1) Particular tests are those tests other than the bachelor's / diploma thesis or the dissertation, which are provided in the case of nationally regulated programs or tests that derive from the particular nature of the respective field (art, theater, medicine, etc.). These are written, oral or practical tests.
- (2) Oral and / or practical tests will be held in front of the licensing committee. These tests are organized in the language in which they were studied.
- (3) The private test (where applicable) not promoted twice in a row, may be repeated in a subsequent session, with the candidate bearing the related expenses, in accordance with the regulations of the organizing institution, established by law. The exceptions are the specializations, respectively the tests in case of which MECTS or the University Senate issues other provisions, respectively those with a curriculum elaborated at national level or examinations that are carried out in groups, for example those in the field of theater. If the graduates repeat one of the tests, the grade obtained in the other test can be recognized in the next session and only then.

Handing over documents

Article 13

- (1) At the end of the exam, the secretary of the commission will complete the minutes with the centralized results .
- (2) The files with the works of the commission of completion of studies, including the works of graduation, license / diploma, dissertation, will be submitted by the secretary of the commission, under signature, to the secretariat of the Faculty for storage and archiving within 5 days from the display of final results. Shelf life is 5 years.
- (3) Diplomas for graduates who have passed the final examination are issued, in the program of studies / specialization graduated, by the organizing institution , within a maximum of 12 months from the date of promotion .

Organizing the bachelor's / graduation / dissertation exam for graduates of study programs organized under Law 84/1995

Article 14⁸

- (1) Study programs organized on the basis of the **Education Law no. 84/1995**, republished , with the subsequent modifications and completions , for the graduates of the previous promotions , the following are finalized :
 - a) with bachelor's / diploma exam , for studies in long-term university education;
 - b) with graduation exam , for studies in short - term university education
 - c) exam for master's degree and in-depth studies.
- (2) For a university / specialization program, the final exam is organized and conducted under the same conditions for all graduates, regardless of the form of education completed or the institution of higher education completed.
- (3) I can take the bachelor's / diploma exam :
 - a. higher education graduates of the study programs / specializations organized on the basis of Law 84/199 5 , which are found in the current structure of the " Lucian Blaga " University of Sibiu.
 - b. graduates who passed the selection exam , according to the provisions of art. 3. to OMECS 3179 / 05.02.2015
- (4) Graduates of temporarily authorized or accredited liquidated study programs / specializations who no longer operate at the national level and who have not taken or failed the graduation exams may take the bachelor's / diploma exam at accredited higher education institutions that have programs of undergraduate studies / similar accredited specializations, established by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education.
- (5) Graduates of master's programs and in-depth studies organized under Law 84/1995, who were accredited / authorized prior to the publication of Law 288/2004, can take the dissertation exam if the profile to which the respective master's program belonged is identical or related to one of the fields of accredited master's degree studies in the current structure of ULBS
- (6) Diplomas for graduates who have passed the final examination are issued in the study program / graduation, within a maximum of 12 months from the date of promotion.

Final provisions

Article 15

- (1) Candidates who have passed the graduation , bachelor's / diploma , dissertation exam are issued the corresponding legal documents . Until the diploma is issued , the candidates who have passed the final exam are issued a certificate of graduation which confers on the holder the same legal rights as the diploma and contains the following information:
 - a) the position, name, surname and signature of the responsible persons in the higher education institution;
 - b) the field of university studies;
 - c) study program / specialization;
 - d) study period;
 - e) average completion of studies;
 - f) the status of accreditation / provisional authorization, the form of education, the language of instruction, the geographical location , the number of credits and the normative act that establishes them (Government decision, order of the minister , as the case may be).
- (2) Candidates who did not pass the final examination will receive, upon request, a certificate of graduation accompanied by a copy of the diploma supplement.
- (3) All the provisions of this Regulation and the evaluation criteria apply in a non-discriminatory manner both to their own students and to students from other state or private universities.
- (4) The faculties of the "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu will inform, in writing, the institutions from which the candidates come about the results obtained by them at the bachelor's exam.
- (5) Within 90 days from the end of the final exam, the following document will be submitted to the Office of Studies, by the faculties: "Diploma Supplement" (diploma annex) issued on standard MECTS printers valid for the respective promotion.
- (6) The Rector may cancel, with the approval of the University Senate, a final examination, a certificate or a diploma of studies when it is proved that he was obtained by fraudulent means or by violating the provisions of the ULBS Charter .

Article 16

- (1) On the date of entry into force of this Regulation , the *Regulation on the organization and conduct of undergraduate and dissertation examinations adopted by the ULBS Senate on 15.09.2009* is repealed .
- (2) This Regulation shall apply starting with the graduates of the academic year 2011 - 2012, as well as the graduates who did not take or did not pass the final exam until its entry into force.

Appendix 1.

**PROCEDURES FOR SUPPORTING THE TEST 1
IN THE FRAMEWORK OF ULBS STARTING WITH THE UNIVERSITY YEAR
2011-2012**

Faculty of Theology: **all specializations take the first test by oral exam**

Faculty of Law: **all specializations take the first test as a written test**

SPECIFICATIONS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES⁹ SUPPORTING UNDERGRADUATE , LICENSE / DIPLOMA, SELECTION AND DISSERTATION EXAMS

- Art. 1** For students with hearing impairments who are speechless (they cannot hear, but can speak, even if not totally grammatically correct , which is why they should not be penalized) the subjects are given in writing , then they answer orally or combined written).
- Art. 2** For unmuted students with hearing impairment (do not hear or speak): - present only the papers in writing ,
- for powerpoint presentation license .
- Art. 3** For visually impaired students :
- only in the Braille system or write on the monitor , provided that the subject is repeated while writing ,
 - supporting the bachelor's thesis: oral only, no powerpoint .
- Art. 4** For students who cannot write the written paper: only oral presentation or to dictate the content of the topic of a teacher of another specialty.
- Art. 5** For students with motor disabilities , the tests will be organized in a building and the hall that will allow access by stroller.
- Art. 6** For students who can only write under limited conditions and cannot dictate the content of another person's homework due to multiple associated deficiencies, grid tests will be written (they have keys and an adapted computer).
- Art. 7** For students with disabilities , the examination time will be increased by 1.5 hours.
- Art. 8** For students with somatic deficiencies , who have problems with sphincter regulation , it will be allowed to go to the toilet with a companion (teacher).
- Art. 9** For students who are under medical treatment (drugs of any type or insulin) will be allowed to ensure the conditions for performing that treatment during the exam.
